Scope of HTWS guidance - *provisional*

- This guidance outlines the infection prevention and control (IPC) principles required for care workers to work safely during this stage of the COVID-19 pandemic and to support quality of life and care within adult social care settings in England.
- It builds on previous How to Work Safely guidance for care homes and domiciliary care, adopting learning from COVID-19, applying evidence and best practice based on consensus opinion of stakeholders including guidance users and IPC specialists who work in community settings.
- The guidance recognises the importance of vaccination against flu and COVID (which includes the booster dose) against symptomatic infection in those at highest risk from developing severe COVID-19 and the continued risk of emergent variants of respiratory viruses including COVID-19.

Standard infection control principles

- 1. Resident Placement/Assessment for infection risk
- 2. Hand Hygiene
- 3. Respiratory and Cough Hygiene
- 4. Personal Protective Equipment
- 5. Safe Management of Care Equipment
- 6. Safe Management of Care Environment
 - Decontamination/domestic cleaning
- 7. Safe Management of Linen
- 8. Safe Management of Blood and Body Fluid Spillage
- 9. Safe Disposal of Waste
- 10. Occupational Safety: Prevention and Exposure Management (including sharps)
- 11. Outbreak management – key points (cohorting principles)

Updated timeline - 24 Nov 2021
