WHO CAN SERVE ON THE CRS BOARD? We are looking for a vibrant, enthusiastic student from Avon Lake High School who is interested in making a difference in our community.

TERM LENGTH? The board term for student representative is 2 years, with an optional year if applicable. The term begins in July 2024.

WHEN DOES THE BOARD MEET? The CRS Board meets six times per year via Zoom, on the 3rd Tuesday of the month in January, March, May, July, September, and November. Meetings start at 7:30 PM and last for approximately 1 ½ hours. The September meeting is the Board/Staff retreat and is typically in-person and lasts 3 hours.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend Board of Directors meetings and committee meetings as applicable.
- Support and participate in special events (e.g., Charity Ball, SOUPer Bowl Food Drive, and Homeruns for Hunger). Our two youth representatives take on leadership roles in facilitating the SOUPer Bowl each year.
- Promote CRS mission and represent the agency at your high school and in the community.
