Discussion of Boosterthon Funds-**Jessica Ward and EC**

- This year it will be held on 2/28/2020
- We need 10-15 parent volunteers to help run stations, more information will be sent out as the event gets closer
- Goal is \$22,500.00
  - Similar to last year's fundraising goal

- The funds will be distributed as follows: 75% directly to the classroom 25% back to PTA reserve
- That leaves approximately 16,875 to work with
  - Three options on what to do with the funds from this year:
    - option 1 – 2comp per classroom (30 classrooms) leaves about 5,667.60 for books
    - option 2- 2 computer per 26 classrooms (1 computer per focus classroom); leaving \$6,414.76 for books
    - option 3- 3 computers per classroom, leaving no money for books
  - Discussion was held and notes are as follows:
    - Focus teacher, Ms. Jaime Johnson prefers keeping all computers allocated the same, so that focus teachers can focus on their high quantity of students in their classroom the same way homeroom teachers can;
    - Julianna Weigel asked if the books would travel with the teacher or belong to the school
      - Principal Johnson said that the books would be barcoded and stay with the school
    - Parent posed a question of what is the use of computers like in the classroom?
      - Teacher Kellie Hill responded and said students can take AR tests and things like that; assessments can be done on the computers in classrooms
      - Principal Johnson says a lot of group work is done on computers, seesaw work is done on computers and shared with parents
    - Ms. Jaime Johnson said technology in the hands of our students is powerful, there is a lot you can do with it. Essentially \$200 per teacher to spend on books would not go as far as more technology
      - Several other parents agreed
    - Heather Worsham asked if the number of classrooms changes for the next school year how would that be handled in computer distribution?
      - Kristin Barton- could be worked as a line item to address one or two classrooms, or if there wasn't enough for 3 computers per classroom the surplus would go to the next year
  - Voted on options presented-
    - Unanimous vote in favor of spending all money raised on computers for the classrooms
