

ART CONTEST: DIVERSE PERSPECTIVES

DESCRIPTION: This is an open call to Fullerton College students to display artwork representing diversity throughout the college as part of the Diverse Perspectives Art Competition. Selected Artworks will be on display from June 2019 to May 2020.

REQUIREMENTS:

- All 2-dimensional traditional and digital media is eligible, including drawing, painting, digital art, design, photography, printmaking, mixed-media, and all print media.
- This "Diverse Perspectives" art contest is open to all Fullerton College students; must be currently enrolled in 3 units or more.
- Only original works may be submitted. Maximum entries: 1
- Entries must conform to the Fullerton College Standards of Student Conduct and Discipline.
- If selected for display, you must provide a short statement about the work, 200-300 words.

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION: This is a juried show. If your artwork is selected, student artwork will be on display throughout the college for a year. Students will be contacted when the artworks have been removed, and can choose to pick up artwork or donate the work to the college. Unclaimed artworks will be considered donated to the college.

SUBMISSIONS: All entries must be registered/received by May 8th, 2019, 3:00pm. Please fill out this entry form and bring it with the original artwork to the Art Department Office, 2nd Floor, 1000 building. No late submissions will be admitted. Art Department Faculty will jury the entries.
