CalFresh can help you buy healthy  
foods on a Student Budget!



**Part Time students – May qualify under other CalFresh regulations**  
**Full Time Students – Must be employed a minimum of 20 hours per week and get paid (or participate in one of the following programs)**

In addition, Full Time students may qualify for a work exemption if you participate in ONE of the following programs:

- Eligible or have been awarded work study
- Enrolled in EOP/EOPS
- College Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS)
- In an on-the-job training program
- Receiving CalWORKs and/or CARE benefits
- Guardian Scholars Program
- Have a child under age 6 or between 6 and 12 and no childcare is available
- A single parent who attends school full-time and has a child under age 12
- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
- Cal Grant A or B recipient
- Puente Project
- Cooperative Agencies Resource Education (CARE) program
- Mathematics, Engineering Science Achievement (MESA) program
- Chafee Educational training voucher program

You cannot get CalFresh if you have a meal plan that provides more than 50% of your meals

**NOTE:** Student Financial Aid is not counted as income for CalFresh

**NOTE:** Students under age 22 living with their parents must apply with their parents as a household

**If you do not have all of the required documents you can still apply!**

**Required Documents:**

1. ID for all adults
2. Proof of income
3. Social Security numbers

Proof of living expenses (such as rent, gas bill, electric bill, water bill, telephone/cellphone bill, childcare expenses)

(Effective Oct 1, 2017 – Sept 30, 2018)

1 person: \$2,010 per month

2 people: \$2,708 per month

3 people: \$3,404 per month

4 people: \$4,100 per month

5 people: \$4,798 per month

6 people: \$5,494 per month

7 people: \$6,190 per month

8 people: \$6,888 per month

Each additional person: +\$698 per month
