## Information on 1099 tax changes

In January, I emailed you about a change to the IRS tax code (found here) that could be interpreted to change the reporting rules for auction companies: namely, it lowered the 1099k threshold to \$600 (from \$20,000).

We know from the development of this part of the code that it is intended to ensure that "gig" workers, paid through Venmo, PayPal, etc. have their income reported. However, the definition of a Third Party Settlement Organization could be interpreted to mean an auction company.

As we know, it takes time for even the IRS to examine its own changes to rule on how they apply to different situations, and we promised to keep pushing and keep asking until we had something to report that was reliable. I'm pleased to report that we have that information, and I'm even more pleased to report that this answer comes as a direct result of NAA Members working through NAA.

At Day on the Hill in April, Lance Walker, CAI, BAS, CES, and Past President Terri Walker, CAI, BAS, CES, met with a representative from their Congressman David Kustoff's office, who took the following questions to the Internal Revenue Service:

"Would an auction company, operating online, with whom sellers do not establish escrow accounts, are unrelated to the sellers, who have agreements regarding payments to sellers, be considered a Third party Settlement organization under IRS tax code, be obligated to report payments to the IRS and issue a 1099k?"

Below is the answer direct from the IRS Chief Counsel's office:

"...(w)e would tend to think that the auction firm is not a Third Party Settlement Organization with a reporting obligation under section 6050W of the Internal Revenue Code."

With this information direct from the IRS along with several more "off the record" recommendations from tax professionals, the NAA believes that auction companies are not TPSOs and do not have any new reporting obligations. As always, we recommend that you consult with your own tax professionals to make the final determination for your business.

I sincerely hope that this information helps you and your business... and I'm so proud and thrilled to report this fantastic example of Auctioneers Helping Auctioneers!

I am a hoof trimmer for Dairy cows, traveling about a 45 mile radius from home. Seven or eight years ago I began to really think about the future of the Dairy industry and wonder how the changes taking place would affect me. As the small Dairy's continue to disappear and there are fewer farms milking more cows I thought it might be wise to diversify my work. Not having all my "eggs in one basket" seemed like a good idea. I also needed some variation from trimming 6 days a week.

In November of 2016, I went to World Wide College of Auctioneering. I hadn't been to an auction in years, didn't have any auctioneer friends, really didn't know what I was

getting into. I'd had a lot of fun going to auctions with my Dad as a boy and our Church had recently started an annual fundraiser where they asked me to call bids.

I still remember the morning in class when they talked about Contract Auctioneers. I had no idea there was such a thing! After auction school I dabbled in starting my own auction service. I soon found out that my full time hoof trimming

schedule didn't allow adequate time to try and launch my own auction business. Being unwilling to let the auctioneering idea totally slip away I decided to cast myself out there as a contract auctioneer. That was 4 years ago that I started as a contract guy and I'm still amazed at how it has taken off!

With me being located in central Michigan it has helped me crisscross the state in my travels. I've driven from Detroit to Charlevoix, Spring Lake to Frankenmuth, Gaylord to Milan, Lupton to Marshall and everywhere in between calling bids. I've helped with livestock auctions, horse auctions, gun auctions, coin auctions, small animal auctions, equipment auctions, estate auctions, tool auctions, antique auctions, real estate auctions, consignment auctions (where there can be literally anything and everything) as well as fundraising auctions. The variety of items I've sold is even more varied than the type of auctions I've helped with! Interestingly enough, my highest selling item was at my very first sale. It was a Case tractor for \$55,000.





Nearly every weekend throughout the year I can be found working for some established auction company within the state. All this has been made possible through the connections made at the MAA Conferences! I still really don't know why so many individuals were willing to give me a try or help me get into this career. I no longer trim cows on Saturday's and my schedule is more flexible during the week if someone needs assistance. Attending the conferences has now truly become a family reunion with my many many auctioneer friends.

I'd like to give a shout out to all those who have hired me in the past, I look forward to helping you all again as well as others in the future.
