

WELCOME.US CITIZEN GUIDE PROGRAM

Prepare for your citizenship interview and test with a volunteer

Welcome.US is launching a new citizenship preparation program to support lawful permanent residents (green card holders) on their path to U.S. citizenship. Through this program, you can select from three different offerings to be matched one-on-one with a trained volunteer who will help you prepare for your citizenship exam, practice your English language skills, and provide encouragement and mentorship throughout your journey. Volunteers will meet with you online at a mutually convenient time.

What the program offers:

- English conversation practice focused on language skills needed for citizenship and to increase confidence in your communication skills (~8–10 weekly 60-min sessions)
- Citizenship test preparation, which includes practicing the civics questions, English writing, reading and comprehension (~10 weekly 60-min sessions)
- Citizenship interview preparation through mock interviews (1–2 60-min sessions to role-play an interview)

What the program does not offer:

The Citizen Guide program is strictly a tutoring and mentorship program. Volunteers do not:

- Provide legal advice
- Act as attorneys or accredited representatives
- Complete or assist with the N-400 application form
- Teach English as a Second Language (ESL)
- Offer translation during sessions

Who is eligible for this program:

This program serves newcomers who meet ALL of the requirements below:

- Currently a lawful permanent resident (green card holder). The Citizenship Test Preparation offering is available to green card holders who have already applied (submitted their N-400 form), or are planning to apply for U.S. citizenship within the next 1–2 years.
- At least 18 years old
- Have at least a basic English proficiency and are comfortable and ready to engage in conversations in English
