<p><b>*Call to Worship</b> (Deut. 5: 12-15) Observe the Sabbath day and keep it holy. <b>Six days we labor and do all our work – but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord our God.</b> Remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, but God brought you out from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. <b>We, and the resident alien in our towns, and all creatures, great and small, rest;</b> Let us give thanks and praise to God who has set us free!</p>

<p><b>Corporate Prayer of Confession</b> God of the outstretched arm, though you lead us into freedom, we choose again and again the chains of sin. Forgive us, we pray, for bowing to the false gods of our time. We believe we have made ourselves, rather than being made in your image – the work of your hands. We practice legalism against others, yet expect exceptions for ourselves. We rest in ease, while others bear heavy burdens on our behalf. Heal us where we are withered in hand or heart of faith. Stretch us beyond what we have managed or imagined, to live as you intend and command. In the name of Christ, who came to set us free...<i>(silent prayers of confession)</i></p>		
<p><b>Declaration of Forgiveness</b> Psalm 32 says: “Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.” Through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, we are those happy people whose sins have been forgiven.
