As each jar is made by hand any growth in their company would need to be made very deliberately to keep the authenticity of the product.

Patrick prides himself on the quality of his pickles. Last year he won the Good Food Award for his Lime Tarragon flavor, which he states has a subtle flavor of the lime that is balanced with the sweeter tarragon.
