

## PENNSYLVANIA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

CHILDREN OF ALL GRADES (K-12) NEED THE FOLLOWING IMMUNIZATIONS FOR ATTENDANCE:

4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis

**4 doses of polio (4<sup>th</sup> dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)**

2 doses of MMR

3 doses of hepatitis B

2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade ADDITIONAL immunization requirements for attendance:

**2 doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV).** First dose is given 11-15 years of age: second dose is required at age 16 or entry into 12<sup>th</sup> grade; if one dose was given at age 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required.

1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)
