My Turn To Drive School is offering Driver's Education classes open to **Archbishop Carroll** students this school year. Students who complete this PA Department of Education approved theory course would also be eligible to test privately for their driver's license with My Turn To Drive School after completing 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction. The upcoming theory courses will consist of classroom sessions in defensive driving practices and techniques covering various types of driving environments and risk avoidance strategies. Students can enroll at the age of 15 and above, and your daughter/son does not need a driving permit in order to participate in the class.

The Fall 2019 class will begin after school in room 212 on Monday, October 7th and will continue on 10/9, 10/14, 10/16, 10/21, 10/23, 10/28, 10/30, 11/4, 11/6, 11/11, 11/13, 11/18, 11/20 and conclude on November 25th.

The Winter 2020 class will begin after school in room 212 on Monday, January 13th and will continue on 1/15, 1/22, 1/27, 1/29, 2/3, 2/5, 2/10, 2/12, 2/19, 2/24, 2/26, 3/2, 3/4 and conclude on March 9th.

Winter Saturday morning sessions from 9am until noon are also available at The Haverford School

My Turn to Drive School specializes in teaching young teenage novice drivers. Our school has been operating on the Main Line for over 15 years. All instructors are college graduates, experienced, and fully certified and licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to teach the Defensive Driving safety course.

There are three major reasons for offering this defensive driving course. First, the development of the proper attitude toward defensive driving is a most important trait to instill in a young driver. Second, if your teenager **successfully completes an accredited driver-training course you may save up to 15% on yearly insurance premiums for your son or daughter until their 21st birthday.** Third, students may be eligible to obtain a senior license at age 17 1/2, instead of age 18, if parental permission is obtained, and all requirements are met.

The fee for the classroom instruction is \$225.00 and includes all classroom materials. If you plan to permit your teenager to drive the family car or one of their own, this course offers the peace of mind that you have provided the best learning opportunity for driving defensively.
