Minimum Requirements

Your application will not be considered unless the following requirements are met:

1. Must be a graduating student from a high school in Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, or Sarasota Counties, who will matriculate at the University of Florida in 2019-2020.
2. Must be of African descent (ex. African American, West Indian, etc).
3. Must have a minimum un-weighted cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
4. Must attach **completed** application, résumé, and an essay that answers the following: *How do you plan to get involved at the University of Florida to have a positive impact on the black community?*

Submission Requirements
