SUSTAINABLE PENNSYLVANIA COMMUNITY CERTIFICATION

- The City of Harrisburg became a Certified Silver Sustainable Pennsylvania Community on March 1st 2018
- The process to resubmit to be recognized as a Certified Gold Community has been started.
- Harrisburg should be a Certified Gold Community in 2020





- Harrisburg EAC reformed in 2018
- Worked with housing authority to build up existing Environmental Teen Corp in 2019




- Collaborative working group comprised of City Employees, NGOs, Community Activists, Educators, etc. working to restore Greenhouse.
- \$30,000 raised so far to cover costs of Planning and Design
- Plans for community involvement, preparation of food grown here in adjacent Brownstone building.



Renewable Energy

- City of Harrisburg signed contract with Direct Energy, as of April of 2019 for approximately 1/3rd of Municipal Electricity to be generated from Renewable Sources.
- Current plans, future applications to establish local renewable energy source to supply municipal power. Attempting collaboration with Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority.

Calendar Year (CY) 2018-2019 rev 03/2019

- \$40,000 Grant awarded from DEP Driving PA forward will install 8 electric vehicle charging stations on 3rd Street in Harrisburg at State Museum.
- Plans to apply in 2020 to install additional publicly available stations on City Island.
- City Island stations will be used to charge City of Harrisburg fleet vehicles during off-hours, start conversion of City Fleet to EV.
