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### Executive Committee Elections Timeline

- June 30, 2021 - final deadline for nominations
- August 27- ballots can be distributed for voting (45 days before Annual Meeting)
- October 10- deadline for announcement of results

### Executive Committee Roles and Responsibilities

The Executive Committee is the governing body of the MANP and the guiding leaders of the organization's activities. MANP's leaders are the public face of Montana's naturopathic community and the key to collaboration and communication with other health care professions, the public, and colleagues nationally.

The Executive Committee meets regularly, twice monthly at a minimum. Preparation time for regular and special meetings are also required of EC members. Additional duties may include chairing or serving on standing or special committees.

An estimated 150 minimum up to 300 hours annually is estimated, or 2-4 hours average weekly in addition to legislative travel and conference attendance.

Additional EC duties in service of appointed working groups, strategic planning, conference planning and presentation, legislative engagement, and general organizational and event/conference participation can be anticipated.

EC members will engage in an Orientation process with additional meetings leading up to their first EC meeting in January.



Nominees will be required to confirm a commitment to serve in the office for the applicable term by signing the nomination form and providing a 500 word letter to the membership and providing a bio not to exceed 200 words.

### **Offices to be Filled**

President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary

Two- Year Terms: January 2022 - December 2023

Nominees to the Executive Committee must be Regular Members of the MANP for at least 2 years immediately prior to nomination for election to Executive Committee. (Governance Policies rev.2017 A13)
