REGISTRATION

Registration is the same for all Nobles, Daughters, and Associates. Advance Registration is \$100.00 and On-site registration is \$150.00. The Registration fee covers both Desert Conference and Gala Day. The three (3) Principal Officers from the Temple and Court and all Imperial Appointed Officers must register, whether they attend or not (**these funds are non-refundable**). **The deadline for the three (3) Principal Officers and all Imperial Appointed Officers is Tuesday, March 1, 2022.** Temples and Courts are requested to pre-register their Nobles and Daughters using the 2022 Desert Conference/Gala Day registration forms, located on the Desert of Florida website at www.aeonmsflorida.org. There is a cut-off date for Advanced Registration on Sunday, May 1, 2022 (No Exceptions). Any registration and fees received after May 1, 2022, will be considered ON-SITE registration at \$150.00.

ADVANCE REGISTRATION REFUND

In the event a Noble or Daughter registers in advance and cannot attend, the Imperial Deputy of/for the Desert of Florida must be notified five (5) days in advance of the Desert Conference and Gala Day. Exceptions will be made for EMERGENCIES ONLY.

DRESS CODE FOR DESERT CONFERENCE/GALA DAY

NOBLES: Coat and tie preferred but not mandatory. Shrine walking suits, jumpsuits, jackets, sweat/t-shirts may be worn as casual wear. The Fez and Collar will not be worn with t-shirts, shorts, cutoffs or other inappropriate dress. Nobles should use good judgment and wear attire appropriate for the occasion.

DAUGHTERS: The official attire for the Daughters (which is meeting attire) shall be white dress, white lingerie, all white shoes (Lucite and mesh shoes are permissible), white stockings, white bag, white gloves (no fingerless gloves) and regulation Fez. Flowers (corsages) should be all white, no green foliage. No silver or gold jewelry (including ankle bracelets) shall be worn with regalia, except as followed by the Imperial Court.

GALA DAY MANDATORY DRESS

Nobles

1. Dress for the Memorial Service, Public Program and the Opening Session (all Nobles) is White Dinner Jacket, Black Pants, White Shirt W/Collar (Please, no Banded Collar Shirts), Black Tie, (Bow Tie Preferred), White Gloves and Fez.
2. Dress for the afternoon Session for Desert Officers, Imperial Officers and any Noble who desires is Red Jacket, Tie, Black Pants, Fez and White Gloves.
3. Dress for Deputies Ball & Dinner is White Dinner Jacket, Black Pants, White Gloves. and Fez with accessories.

Daughters

The formal attire of the Daughters shall be white, formal length to the top of the shoe, dress (no tea length) white lingerie, all-white shoes, white stockings, crystal or rhinestone jewelry, white handbag, white gloves (no fingerless gloves) and regulation Fez. Long gloves are required with sleeveless or strapless gowns. A strapless gown must be worn with a non-revealing and large enough formal jacket or shawl covering the upper body. White sequins and rhinestones should not reflect color. Splits in gowns shall be no higher than the knee and no gowns with trains, as it presents a safety hazard to the wearer and others as well. Silver or gold jewelry is not worn with regalia as allowed by the Imperial Court.

Exceptions to the limitations shall be watches, rings, medic alert bracelets, small gold official Isis pins, Past Illustrious Commandress pins, Pillar pendants (on a fine gold chain), and Shrine 100th Commemorative Medallions.
