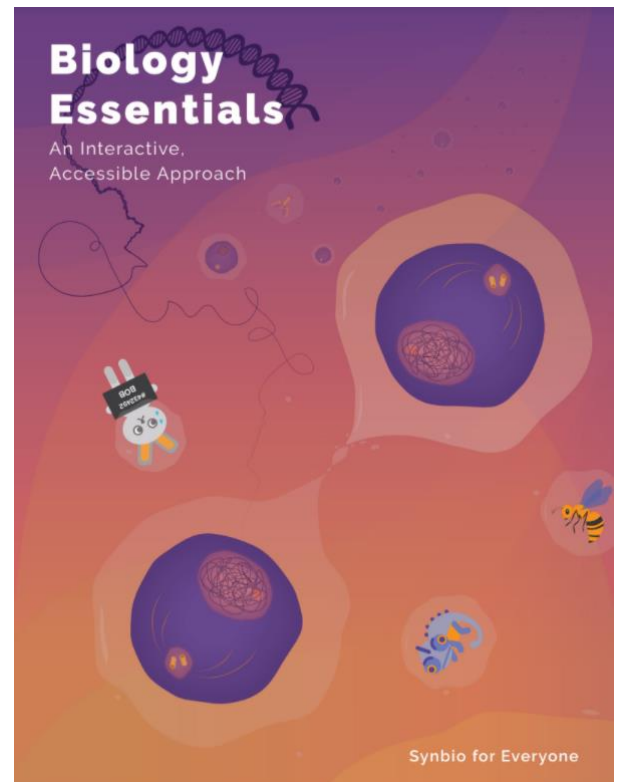


Free Inclusive Biology Curriculum



- Synbio for Everyone is a nonprofit organization that has developed an award-winning 400-paged **inclusive, hands-on** biology curriculum.
- 19 activities for students K-12 cover a broad range of biology essentials and have been developed using a Universal Design perspective to be inclusive for people with disabilities.
- Activities come with videos to facilitate remote learning, audio versions with adaptations for the visually impaired, diagrams to facilitate students with intellectual disabilities, and captions to ensure screen reader accessibility.

- This curriculum has been tested with autistic students, students with visual impairments, and students at underserved schools in 5 countries encompassing 3 continents.
