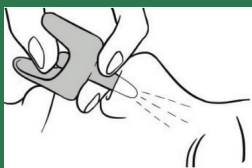
Remember to keep all medications, even pet medications, locked up to prevent misuse, and to safely dispose of expired or unused medications year-round.

- Fentanyl is a highly potent opioid.
- A few grains of fentanyl can be deadly and can take only a few minutes after ingesting to be fatal.
- Fentanyl can be added, without user knowledge, to black market knock-off prescription medications, heroin, methamphetamines, cocaine, vape pens, and marijuana/cannabis.
- Call 211 to locate treatment and/or for information on how to obtain free naloxone (Narcan®); or talk to your pharmacist to purchase Narcan® if you or someone you know may be at risk.
