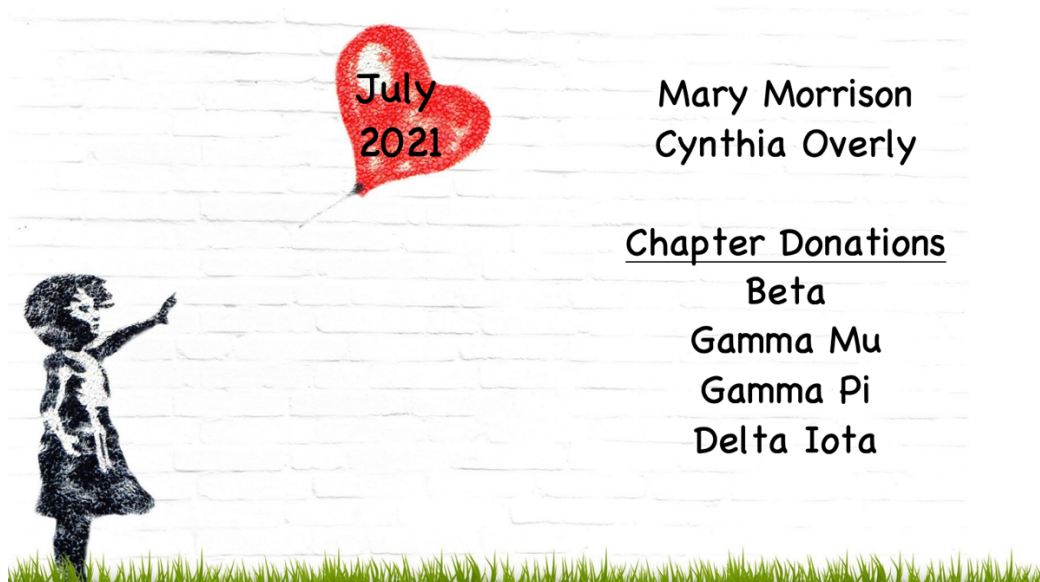

Oh...is this the August edition of *The Voice*...I forgot that it's too soon to reveal our promotion!

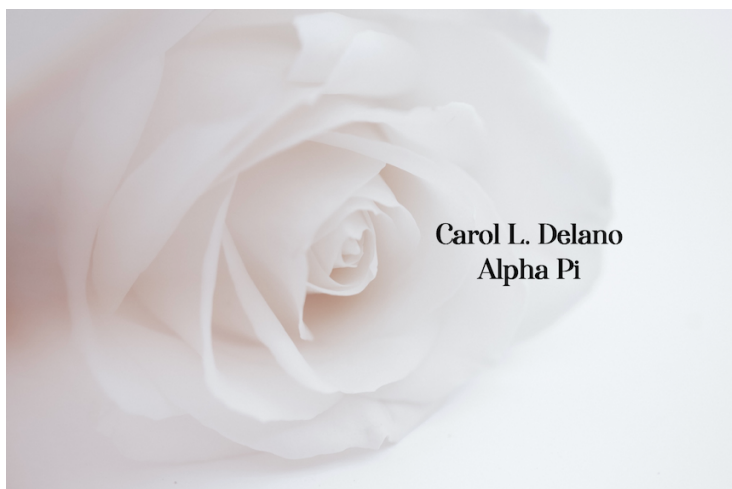
We will be revealing in an upcoming edition of *The Voice*, our exciting membership promotion plan to share with each OSO DKG chapter member that includes....
