ATTENTION CHAPTER WEBMASTERS

Beginning August 1, 2022, through October 31, 2022, all chapter webmasters **MUST** review their websites. They must make sure it is up to date and all information is correct. After checking, webmasters will access Form 72 (Society Website Compliance Assurance) on the International website. Upon completion of the online form, International will send a new 2022-2024 Compliance Seal, usually within two weeks. This seal will replace the 2020 - 2022 seal.
