Their catalog lists handbell music under 'Percussion'.

On a recent visit, I learned that the Library, now housed in a beautiful new facility, is eager to increase its handbell catalog, particularly with multiple copies of titles. The current collection lists a few hundred titles, but unfortunately, most of those are single copies. With a little effort and donations from handbell directors, that can soon change.

How does it all work? For a small annual membership fee, and an even smaller rental cost, the library will ship your request as quickly as possible.
