



US-95, Fruitland to Payette

Construction Update June 21 to July 5

Paving work begins in Fruitland June 15

Crews have started paving operations on US-95 in between 24th Street and the south end of the Payette River Bridge in Fruitland.

Motorists should expect

- At least one lane open in each direction
- Reduced speed limits
- Delays, consider alternative routes

Additional curb and gutter work continues in between 11th St and 24th St.

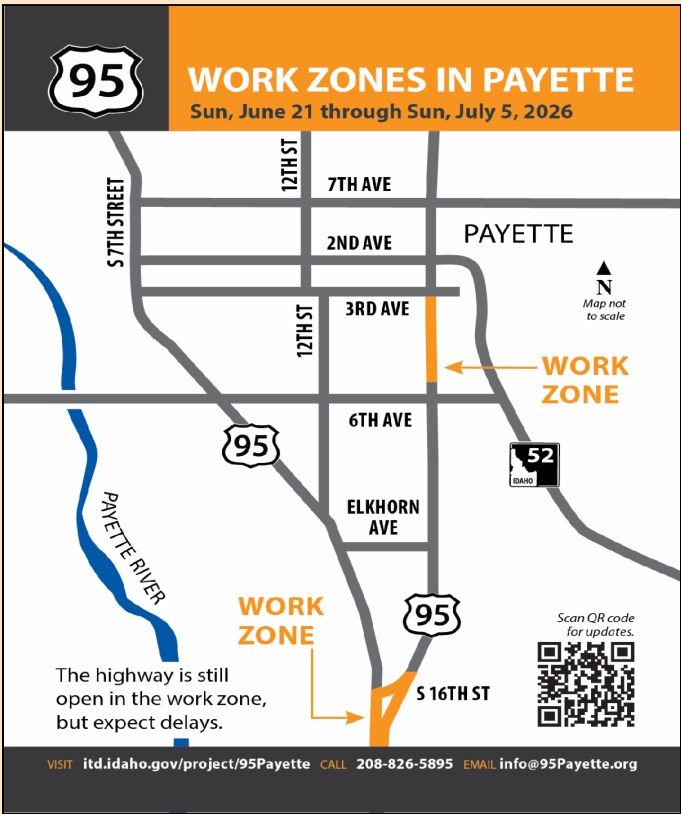


US-95/NW 24th St, facing north.

Paving on US-95 continues between the Y intersection in Payette and the Payette River Bridge.

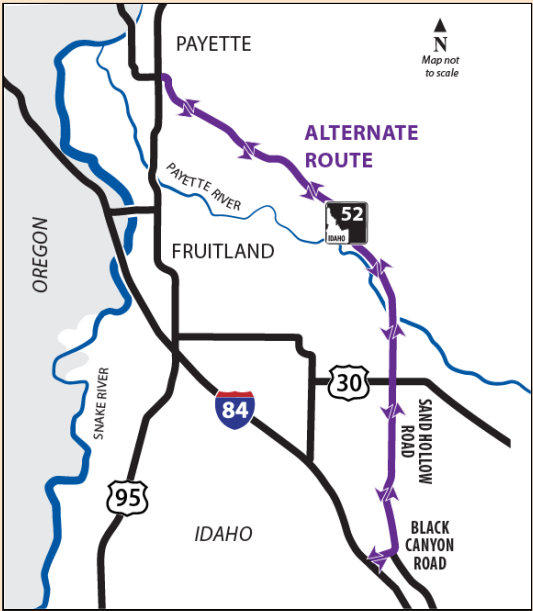
In other locations, crews continue replacing pipes in and around the road, along with curbs and gutters.

What to expect

- Daytime and nighttime work
- Lane closures on US-95 depending on activity and location
 - Single lane closures
 - Reduced to one lane with flaggers where necessary
- Reduced speed limits
- Delays, consider using an alternate route
