No tank tops, half shirt, spaghetti straps, tube tops, bare midriffs, or back revealing dress/ shirts are permitted. For safety reasons, shoes must remain on at all times during the event. Shoes must have a heel strap and should not have a heel exceeding 2” (two inches) in height. Ballerina-style flat shoes are highly recommended.
