7th Grade Weekly Information

FROM THE TEACHERS:

Canvas: Please make sure that you and your child are checking Canvas daily. The teachers are using the calendar as a homework page for assignments and tests so that students can keep up with their school work. Many students are not completing their homework, and teachers want to make sure both parents and students have increased visibility into upcoming assignments in order to complete homework successfully.

Dress Code: We continue to see repeated dress code infractions in the same areas. Please work with your child to make sure that they are coming to school compliant with dress code policies.

- Boys hair: Hair must not come below the eyebrows or touch the ears or top of the shirt collar.
- Girls skirts: Skirt length must be no more than 4" above the knee.

Fully Charged Laptops: Please make sure students are coming to school with a fully charged laptop each day. Classrooms are not equipped to be charging laptops during class and students are not allowed to share chargers due to COVID restrictions. To ensure that students do not miss vital instruction, it is important that they are fully prepared for class each morning.

7th GRADE NEWS & REMINDERS:

Holy Week & Easter Break: Please remember that Thursday, April 1st is a Minimum Day, as it is Holy Thursday. There will also be no school on Friday, April 2nd in observance of Good Friday. School will resume from Easter break on Monday, April 12th.

Out of Town Travel Reminder: In December 2020, St. Serra received a directive from the Diocese of Orange that stated: Students and families who travel out of state can transition to distance learning for 14 days (now 10 days) upon their return or are requested to provide a negative COVID-19 test result for re-entry to campus. While this directive does apply to the Holidays, St. Serra is committed to remaining open for in-person instruction so as a result, we will continue to follow this directive for all out of state travel from now through the end of the 2020-2021 school year.
