School Attendance Required

Attendance at school on the 24th of February is a requirement for all dance participants. Students who are absent on the day of the dance will not be eligible to attend. Students must arrive at school no later than break time (10:00 am) on the day of the dance.

Cell Phone & Electronics*

Absolutely NO electronic devices will be permitted in the dance; this includes cell phones, Apple watches, AirPods, or any other electronic devices. It is recommended that students leave their cell phones at home or with a parent. ***NOTE: ALL CELL PHONES & DEVICES WILL BE COLLECTED AT THE DOOR.**

Arrival at the Dance

Students may arrive at the dance between **6:45 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.** After 7:30 p.m., the doors will be closed, and students will not be allowed in. Only assigned chaperones will be admitted to the Student Activities Center (SAC) during the dance, so please plan to take photographs at home or before students enter the dance.

Dismissal from the Dance

The dance **ends promptly at 9:00 p.m.** Parents must be at the school by 9:00 p.m. to pick up their son/daughter. If a student is not picked up by 9:00 p.m., he/she will wait inside the SAC with a teacher or an administrator, and the parents will be contacted.

Dress Code Guidelines*

ABSOLUTELY NO COSTUMES - All attire must be in accordance with all school non-uniform dress code requirements. **The dress code for the dance must reflect modesty and good taste.** The dance is considered a semi-formal event, and thus, students are expected to follow the guidelines for semi-formal attire. Students unable to comply with the dress code will be refused admittance. Students with concerns about the appropriateness of their attire may submit a picture of themselves wearing the outfit (front and back) to the administration for approval prior to the event.

Boys are required to wear collared shirts (no logos or messages), appropriately fitted slacks/pants, and dress or school uniform shoes. Students may not wear jeans or shorts, and hair should be well-groomed.

Girls: Dresses, skirts, and tops should not be revealing or too tight (skin tight is not appropriate). No tank tops, low-cut, off-the-shoulder, spaghetti straps, mid-drifts, or back-revealing dresses/shirts. Dress or skirt slits may not be above the knee. For safety reasons, shoes must remain on at all times during the dance. Shoes may not have a heel height exceeding 2" (two inches), and flat shoes are highly recommended.

Makeup should be kept light and look natural; this applies to mascara, blush, lip gloss, eye shadow, and light foundation. Eyeliner and false eyelashes are not permitted. If the makeup is deemed excessive, the student will be asked to remove it before entering the dance.

***NOTE:** If a student arrives with an outfit that does not meet the dress code requirements, he or she will not be permitted to enter the dance. In the event of non-admittance, the student must be picked up and taken home or brought a suitable outfit replacement.

Student Behavior Expectations

Student behavior at the dance must be in line with the school's Catholic Identity and Code of Conduct. Behavior and/or dancing not in keeping with the school's Code of Conduct and Catholic Identity will result in the student losing the privilege of attending the dance, and he/she will be asked to leave the SAC. In the event of removal from the dance, a parent or guardian designee will be required to pick up the student within fifteen minutes of removal.
