FROM THE TEACHERS:

Dress Code: 7th grade teachers have been giving students verbal reminders about proper dress code. We will begin enforcing dress code rules this week. Please make sure that students are in proper dress code for their school day. Recurring infractions, we are seeing daily include: socks, jewelry, and hair. Here are the dress code requirements for those areas. Please reach out to teachers if you have other dress code questions.

- Socks must be plain white, black, grey, or navy with one small, single color logo.
- Students may wear a watch, one Christian necklace, and 1 bracelet. Rings of any kind are not permitted. Girls are allowed a single pair of matching stud earrings only.
- Nail polish is not permitted.
- Boy's hair may not be over the ears, cover the eyebrows, or touch the top of the shirt collar. Hair height may not exceed 1". Sideburns must be trimmed and may be no longer than the middle of the ear.
- Girl's hair must be natural in appearance. It may not be bleached, colored, or highlighted.
- Formal Uniform Requirements: Please make sure that students have their sweater/vest over the appropriate formal top. Boys must wear a belt. Girls must have white knee socks.
