FROM THE TEACHERS:

Biography Report: Fourth Grade students will do an oral presentation on a famous person. They will read a biography about the person, write a script for a presentation, and then present as the person in their report. This assignment requires students to read a biography book about their person and use the information in the book as the basis for their presentation. Students should have finished reading their book by now so they can write their script, put their costume together and be ready to present the week of June 1st.

Year End Testing: Fourth grade will be doing year end testing in Math and ELA the week of May 24th. These are tests on all concepts covered in fourth grade. Students can review Simple Solutions and Envision if they wish to refresh their memory of these concepts. These tests will NOT count toward their grades but are used to help their teachers understand where they are in the learning process. Testing schedule is as follows:

Social Studies Project: In Social Studies class, students will become an entrepreneur and design their own style of jeans. They will also create an advertisement for their jeans.
