Areas that are a common problem are:

- Skirt length: Skirts must be mid-thigh or longer and not rolled
- PE shorts: Shorts are never allowed to be rolled to shorter than mid-thigh.
- Hair: All hair must be above the eyes on both boys and girls and cannot come over the ears or touch the collar in boys (pushing it behind the ears is NOT acceptable)
- Makeup & Nail Polish: These are never allowed in 7th grade.
- **Shirts:** Students must always have the appropriate school shirt on (polo, PE, or spirit). School issued sweatshirts may be worn **OVER** a shirt but never **without** a shirt.
