## WHAT DO CUB SCOUTS DO?

- Fun activities that focus on STEAM, citizenship, healthy living, first aid, sports, hiking, camping, nature, and more.
- Scouts complete activities throughout the year in their Cub Scout handbooks to earn their badge of rank that they receive during a special bridging ceremony at the Year-end Campout.
- Scouts typically meet once a month for den meetings or outings/field trips and are grouped by grade. Scouting is flexible - *If you cannot make a meeting, the activities in the handbooks are easy to complete as a family.*
- The Pack hosts approximately one activity a month, such as: *Day and Overnight Campouts, Archery, BB Gun Range, Hikes, Beach Day, Scout Olympics, Pinewood Derby, Seabase Activities, and more! (Most costs for activities are covered by the membership fee and the Pack Popcorn Fundraiser.)*



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## WHAT DO AMERICAN HERITAGE GIRLS DO?

- The AHG program is dedicated to the mission of building women of integrity through service to God, family, country and community.
- AHG girls participate in badge programs, service projects, leadership opportunities, and outdoor experiences, all with an emphasis on Christian values and family involvement.
- Fun activities include camp outs, hikes, mother-daughter and father-daughter events/activities, and social activities for the entire family.
- Leaders and older girls help the younger girls complete their activities. Award ceremonies are held two times in the scouting year.
- The troop typically meets once a month on a Friday afternoon for meetings. Outings/field trips may be on the weekends. Some meetings are coordinated as a whole troop (Grades K through 12th) and some are by individual squads/grade levels.
- Scouting is flexible. If you cannot make a meeting, the activities in the handbooks are easy to complete as a family. Girls are encouraged to earn badges of their interest and leaders help plan so that the girls may complete their bridging requirements and level awards.
- Leaders register with AHG National, go through background checks and KEYs Youth Protection Training as well as the SJSCS volunteer process while earning Serra Service Hours.
