New Novel: All fourth grade classes will begin a unit on the Gold Rush by reading the novel, *By the Great Horn Spoon* in ELA. This is a wonderful story of adventure set against the backdrop of the Gold Rush about a family from Boston. The novel will be read in class with a focus on plot and character development as well as continuing to work on Figurative Language skills. There will be spelling and vocabulary quizzes from the words in the novel as well as comprehension homework and quizzes throughout the book. The students will focus on the novel through the month of March and into April.
