Welcome to our 24th annual Harvest Festival Talent Show, Serra's Got Talent. This is your chance to show us what you have been working on this year! Please bring your signed and completed audition application with you to your audition on Monday October 15th. The auditions will be held during lunch in the Library. If you are unable to make it then, you are welcome to submit a taped audition via e-mail to Kerry Bernhardt at kbernhardt@ggusd.com.

The Talent Show will be held at this year's Harvest Festival on Sunday, October 28. Exact performance time is dependent on the number of acts chosen to perform.

Please carefully read through the rules before signing your application.

RULES:

- The Talent Show is open to all St. Serra students in Preschool through 8th grade.
- A registration form must be completed by all Talent Show applicants. Bands and Groups please note – EACH registered participant of your group must submit a separate registration form with parent signature.

- All applicants must either bring their registration form with them to the audition or submit it to the St. Serra school office by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 18. There will be NO exceptions.
- Due to limited scheduling and time constraints, not all acts are guaranteed a time to perform in the Talent Show.
- All registration forms will be reviewed by the event committee. Additional information may be required.
- Performances must be “G” rated and appropriate for family viewing.
- Acts must be under 90 seconds in length. Please time your act at home before tryouts.
- Singers must either provide music accompaniment on a CD or MP3 file (no words; look for karaoke versions), sing acapella, or provide their own, pre-approved musical accompanist.
- In the event that multiple acts audition with the same song, the Talent Show committee reserves the right to require that an act change its music. Please keep this in mind when auditioning and, if your music is popular, consider possible backup song selections.
- Music for vocal and dance numbers must be cut to no more than 90 seconds and provided on a CD or MP3 file to the Talent Show Chair by 3:00 p.m. Monday, October 22. If a performer’s music exceeds the 90 second limit we will have to cut it for them.
- Please, NO martial arts or animal acts.
- No equipment will be provided other than a microphone, dance floor and a sound system. If you plan to play an instrument, prior arrangements must be made to get the instrument set up before the show begins. For this reason, no large or cumbersome instruments will be permitted (i.e. while a piano cannot be brought on stage, arrangements may be made to set up a keyboard prior to the start of the Talent Show).
- You may perform 1 solo, duet, trio, OR group; for a total of 1 act per person.
- Auditions will be held in front of the Talent Show Chair (parent volunteer) on a first come first serve basis. Performers should sign in on the sheet posted on the Library doors and wait quietly until their names are called. Your patience is greatly appreciated.
- No acts using batons, pyrotechnics, dangerous equipment, or props displaying violence will be allowed.

- All applicants must abide by our school's Student Code of Conduct.
- Costumes are not required. If they are to be worn, however, costumes must be modest, appropriate for our event and audience, and in keeping with our Catholic values and faith. Costumes must be pre-approved by the Talent Show Chair by Monday, October 22.
- The Talent Show Chair and St. Serra School are not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen properties.

Above all, remember to have fun and show us your talent! The Harvest Festival Talent Show is an opportunity to show our school spirit while celebrating the incredible God-given talents of our SJSC students. Let's make this year's show the best yet!
