FROM THE TEACHERS:

From Mrs. Kim-Saad: Please be sure that your 5-8th grade students have a sketchbook (9"x12") for class. It is a requirement for Art in all middle school. The Student Store carries a few, but they are also available at Target, Walmart, and any place you can find office supplies. A sketchbook is needed for students to sketch and practice their skills for Mrs. Kim-Saad's classes.

Canvas. Please make sure that you and your child are checking Canvas daily. The teachers are using the calendar as a homework page for assignments and tests, so that students can keep up with their school work. Many students are not completing their homework, and teachers want to make sure we have increased visibility into upcoming assignments in order to complete homework successfully.

Dress Code: We continue to see repeated dress code infractions in the same areas. Please work with your child to make sure that they are coming to school compliant with dress code policies.

- Boys hair: Hair must not come below the eyebrows or touch the ears or top of the shirt collar.
- Girls skirts: Skirt length must be no more than 4" above the knee.

Fully Charged Laptops: Please make sure students are coming to school with a fully charged laptop each day. Classrooms are not equipped to be charging laptops during class and students are not allowed to share chargers due to COVID restrictions. In order to ensure that students do not miss vital instruction, it is important that they are fully prepared for class each morning.
