FROM THE TEACHERS:

Biography Report: Fourth Grade students will do an oral presentation on a famous person. They will read a biography about the person, write a script for a presentation, and then present as the person in their report. This assignment requires students to read a biography book about their person and use the information in the book as the basis for their presentation. To prepare for this assignment, please help your student find a biography book about a person they would like to share with the class. Students need to finish reading their book by May 21st so they can write their script, put their costume together and be ready to present the week of June 1st.

Year End Testing: Fourth grade will be doing year end testing in Math and ELA the weeks of May 17th and 24th. These are tests on all concepts covered in fourth grade. Students can review Simple Solutions and Envision if they wish to refresh their memory of these concepts.
