



Accessing Your Child's STAR Testing Results

7th & 8th Grade Parents, Please Register with Home Connect

St. Junipero Serra Catholic School uses a software program called Renaissance to provide teachers with data that helps them make sound instructional choices for your child.

This summer, Renaissance updated their website. In doing so, they have changed how families are able to view their student's STAR testing results. If your students attended St. Serra last year, the link to Renaissance **has changed and there is no longer a parent link.**

In its place, Renaissance has a special feature called Home Connect for all parents, which you can access outside of school from any computer with an Internet Connection. Home Connect allows you to view information about your child's progress. It also allows you to sign up to receive email notifications when your child completes an activity or assessment at school.

You can log in to Home Connect from any computer with an Internet Connection and compatible browser. (For a list of compatible browsers, type the following in any browser: <http://support.renlearn.com/techkb/techkb/10624292e.asp>)

To log in to Home Connect

1. Logon to the new Renaissance Home Connect Website: <https://global-zone53.renaissance-go.com/studentprogress/homeconnect?t=274505>
2. Use your **child's** username and password to login and view results. You will need to login to each child's account individually. (Students were given their passwords in class this week.)
3. Register your email address for notifications

Important Note: At this time, the STAR testing results will NOT be visible in the Home Connect site. All results will be mailed to you directly from Renaissance **from the point you register your email address forward.**
