The dress, skirt or top should not be too tight (skin tight is not permitted) or revealing. Dress or skirt slits may not be above the knee. Girls may wear pants or jeans and a nice top. No tank tops, half shirt, spaghetti straps, tube tops, bare midriffs, or back revealing dress/ shirts are permitted. For safety reasons, shoes must remain on at all times during the event. Shoes must have a heel strap and should not have a heel exceeding 2" (two inches) in height. Ballerina-style flat shoes are highly recommended. Make-up should be kept at a minimum and is limited to mascara, blush, lip gloss, eye shadow, and light foundation.
