



Ash Wednesday Mass – Wednesday, February 17

Ash Wednesday is the beginning of the Lenten Season in our Catholic Church. We begin a 40-day journey of repentance through prayer, fasting and almsgiving to help us grow closer to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We will be celebrating Ash Wednesday Mass this coming Wednesday, February 17, at 10:30 a.m. in the Student Activity Center. Our first grade students and teachers are preparing for this Mass and it will be our first grade students in attendance. Our Chaplain, Father Jim Dunning, will be our celebrant.

Due to COVID-19, we continue to be unable to allow our whole student body to attend Mass, nor are we able to invite parents and guests to join us in person. ONLY first grade students are required to wear their Formal Uniform on this day. Students in the other grades *do not* need to dress in Formal Uniform.

Ashes will be distributed on the forehead using a clean Q-tip for everyone. After Mass, the Eucharistic Ministers will visit the other classrooms to distribute communion or a blessing to the children.

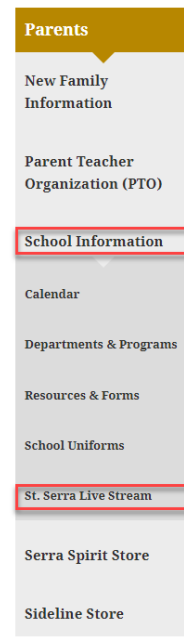
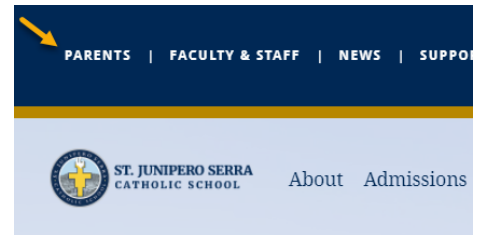
Select the Parents Menu and login with your **personal** FACTS username and password (the same username and password you use to check student grades)

Select the **School Information** link from the left navigation menu
Select **St. Serra Live Stream** from the sub menu

Click on the link provided to view the YouTube live stream

Make sure the red dot next to Live is active to ensure you are viewing the live stream

Note: the link for Mass will be available after 9:00 a.m. the morning of Mass



Important Note:

Since the live stream will be on school's YouTube channel, students who are streaming at home will not be able to access the live stream directly from their school issued iPad or laptop. The teachers will share their screen, or they can login from a personal device since YouTube is currently blocked for students
