FROM THE TEACHERS:

Biography Report: Fourth Grade students will be presenting their biography report in ELA this week. Please help your student find items around the house to dress up in so they look like the person in their biography. Students will be presenting in the first person as if they are the person in the biography book.

Social Studies Project: In Social Studies class, students will become an entrepreneur and design their own style of jeans. They will also create an advertisement for their jeans. This ties into our California history as we have been learning about the amazing entrepreneurs from the Gold Rush era.
