- ★ Topsy Turvy Tuesday -- Students may wear their uniforms in a wacky way. They can put it on backwards, add funky socks or shoes (shoes must meet uniform requirements), add a tie or belt. Boys must wear only boy's uniform clothing and girls may wear only girl's uniform clothing. Students may NOT spray color in their hair or color their hair in any way. Students may not wear non-uniform hats or wigs. Sunglasses may only be worn outside. Students may not wear make-up, except for 8th grade girls who may wear light make-up as usual.

Wednesday, January 30th - Celebrating our Nation

- ★ USA All Day - Students may wear a red, white, or blue top with uniform bottoms. Shirts must be in line with school policy.

Thursday, January 31st - Serving our Community

- ★ Comfy Cozy Day - Students may wear a pajama top (no sleeveless shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, etc.) and pajama pants (no shorts or leggings) as well as "comfy, cozy" shoes (slippers, UGGs, etc. but they MUST be closed toed shoes).
