### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Weekly Information

#### FROM THE TEACHERS:

**Family Life:** All fourth-grade classrooms are in the process of finishing the Family Life program. Please be sure to read and review Lessons 7 through 10 with your student and then send their Family Life book back to the classroom. There will be a quiz on two lessons the week of April 26th and May 3. These are open book tests, so it is important for your student to have their book at school with them.

**Religion:** The fourth-grade students will be doing a report on a saint over the next several weeks. Each student will choose a saint that is of interest to them. They will research this saint to find out about their birth, life, death and how they became a saint. This information will be used to write a multiple paragraph essay in the Jane Shaffer method about the saint. The written presentation will include a prayer for the saint and a hand drawn picture of the saint. After completing the essay, students will present their information to the class. As part of the presentation, each student will dress up as their saint and present in the first person. The presentation will be recorded and posted on SeeSaw. The research and report writing will be done in class. Students will need to create a costume for their presentation from material at home. Students will be able to create a presentation board or poster, if they choose, which will be done out of material from home. The written portion of the project will be due on Friday April 30, 2021. Presentations will begin the week of May 3, 2021. We are all looking forward to this fun and exciting project.
