ADMISSIONS PROCESS



THE APPLICATION PROCESS – PRIORITY DEADLINE, JANUARY 15

JSerra has maintained a priority application deadline of January 15 which allows us to review 8th grade transcripts, recommendations after a full 8th grade semester, and HSPT scores before making admissions decisions. It also gives you time to make the right four-year high school decision for your family.

[Now is the time to submit your application if you have not already done so!](#) It can be completed in less than 30 minutes. Once your application has been submitted, please wait 24-hours for it to be processed then [log back into the Applicant Portal](#). From here you can sign up for the HSPT and request supporting documents.

A complete application will include the following:

- Middle School Transcripts
- Administrator Recommendation
- English Recommendation
- Math Recommendation
- Personal Statement
- High School Placement Test

Additionally, we highly encourage you to complete the optional student essay and pastor recommendation that would give the admissions team the opportunity to get to know you as a whole person.
