Required Boys' Formal Uniform TK – Grade 8 • A white short-sleeved shirt. • A sweater: either a navy long-sleeve V-neck pullover, or a navy sweater vest. • A pair of khaki pants. • Socks in navy or white. • A black belt- required for Grades 3-8 only.
