FROM THE TEACHERS:

Dress Code Reminders:

8th Grade teachers have been giving students verbal reminders about proper dress code. Please make sure that students are in proper dress code for their school day. Please reach out to teachers if you have dress code questions or click [HERE](#) for Parent-Student Handbook for guidelines.

- Girl's skirt length may not be shorter than 4 inches from the top of the knee when a student is kneeling.
- Socks must be plain white, black, grey, or navy with one small, single color logo.
- Boy's hair may not be over the ears, cover the eyebrows, or touch the top of the shirt collar. Hair height may not exceed 1". Sideburns must be trimmed and may be no longer than the middle of the ear.
- 8th Grade girls are permitted to wear "light makeup" consisting only of the following: mascara, light foundation or powder that matches the skin tone, light blush and light lip gloss.
