# Our Mass times are changing!



Dear Solano Family,

I write with great excitement to announce that we are adjusting our Sunday Mass schedule. When I first became your administrator, my vision for this parish focused on "Belong, Believe, Become." To help people feel they belong to this community and to Jesus. To help people believe in Jesus and the Church He instituted. And through this, help people become Christ for others.

I believe making adjustments to the Mass schedule allows us to further this mission and allows us more time to serve you. **Starting Pentecost Sunday (May 23, 2021), we're moving our 10:15 AM Mass to 10:30 AM and 12:00 PM Mass to 12:30 PM. (All other Mass times/services remain the same).**

Changing the two Mass times allows us more time between each Mass to promote community building. Giving this extra time will allow the Solano family to connect, visit, and chat with others outside of Mass. This change helps people feel less like they are being pushed out the door (so that someone else can claim their parking space) and feel more like someone who truly belongs to the community.

When we can once again, you can sit and have a donut and a cup of coffee. You can stop and be present at your church home instead of rushing on to the next event. It would even give the clergy some extra time to stop and chat with you! Eventually, I would love to have brief moments of teaching or formation with this additional time. I dream that we can subsequently add time before and after Mass for more prayer, speakers, or even praise and worship. This would help us be ready for the great prayer of Mass and the reception of the Eucharist. On special days like Pentecost, Palm Sunday, Easter, and others, we would have more time to truly celebrate the Mass in a way that focuses on its solemnity.

These are just a few hopes that I want to bring to our parish and specifically to you. I hope that these changes will bring even greater life to a parish already so alive. I thank you for your continued love and support for this parish family. You belong and know we are doing all we can to serve you and invest in you. God bless you.
