FROM THE TEACHERS:

Walk Through California: The Fourth Grade will experience Walk Through California on February 23 and 24 this year. This is an on-campus event that will take place in the SAC. Each class will have a separate time to experience this wonderful event in a socially distanced atmosphere. Students will receive Expert Word Cards from their Social Studies teacher to memorize prior to the event. Students are encouraged to dress up like a person, place or thing from California history. Please help your student pick something to dress up as that will be easy to make from things you have at home. Students could be a missionary, a gold miner, a farmer, a native American, the Golden Gate Bridge, or anything else from California. More information will be coming home soon about this event! Due to the circumstances this year, parents will not be allowed to observe this event. Please help your student memorize their card and decide on who or what they will dress up as for this memorable Fourth Grade event.

St. Serra Essay: All fourth grade students are participating in a writing contest about St. Serra in their ELA class. Students are researching St. Serra and writing 3 or more paragraphs about his life and impact on California. Toward the end of February, students might bring their work home and ask their parents for help typing the essay. If your child brings it home, please be sure to type exactly what they have written and do not edit it. This copy must match the handwritten copy completed in class to be eligible for the prize. The essays will be completed by the end of February and then sent to the outside group that runs the contest. Two students will win a partial scholarship that will go towards next year's tuition at St. Serra school. Be sure to ask your students about their work!

This needs to be completed by the end of February so the books can be returned to school the first week of March. Students will take quizzes on these lessons in early March.
