- **Boys** are expected to wear collared shirts with a tie and slacks.
- > **Girls** are expected to wear a dress or blouse (and skirt) that does not show above the neckline cut of the robe. Makeup for the girls must be in keeping with the school guidelines.
- > Students will be permitted to remain in their dress clothes for the remainder of the day or may change into the uniform of the day. Students should have a comfortable pair of shoes to change into after pictures are done.
- Parents will receive via email, proofs and picture packages to choose from within a couple of weeks after pictures are completed.
