How long will the drill take? The drill will last approximately 20-25 minutes.

What do parents need to do? We do not need parents to participate in the drill here on campus. You may choose to talk to your child about the drill before and/or after to get a sense of what they are feeling. We also encourage parents to participate in the Great California Shake Out at home or in your place of business.
