### ***Wednesday, February 17th***

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 17th. While not a Holy Day of Obligation, all are encouraged to begin the Lent Season by receiving ashes during one of our services.

We will have our Daily Mass in English at 6AM and 8AM. We will also have Prayer Services with distribution of ashes in English and Spanish.

*Please note that Ash Wednesday is a day of universal fast and abstinence for all Catholics.*

*Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.*

*Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.*

*Catholics ages 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.*
