

Upward COVID19 Safety Plans

We have put together a comprehensive plan to provide a safe environment for this year's Upward Basketball League. Even though things may look a little different this year, we are confident that we can proceed in a safe manner. There are many ways that we will be accomplishing this.

The following are just some of the ways:

- Face masks will be required of all spectators.
- Temperatures will be taken of all coaches and players as they arrive.
- A maximum of two spectators per child will be allowed in the gym.
- Bleacher and chair seating will be arranged to comply with safe social distancing guidelines.
- Drinking fountains will be closed.
- Players will be encouraged to bring their own water bottles each week.
- There will not be a concession stand this year.
- Only the players & spectators for the current game will be allowed in the facility. Once a game ends, those teams & spectators will exit through designated doors. Once they have exited, the next team & spectators may enter the facility.
- Teams will be assigned their own practice balls and each game will have their own specific game ball. All balls will be sanitized every week.
- Each player will have their own set of colored wristbands for the games, so that they are not sharing wristbands.
- Bathrooms & high-profile touching areas will be cleaned several times throughout the evening.
- Plenty of hand sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the facility.
- Evaluations in December will only be for NEW participants. If you have participated before, you will not need to attend an evaluation.
