


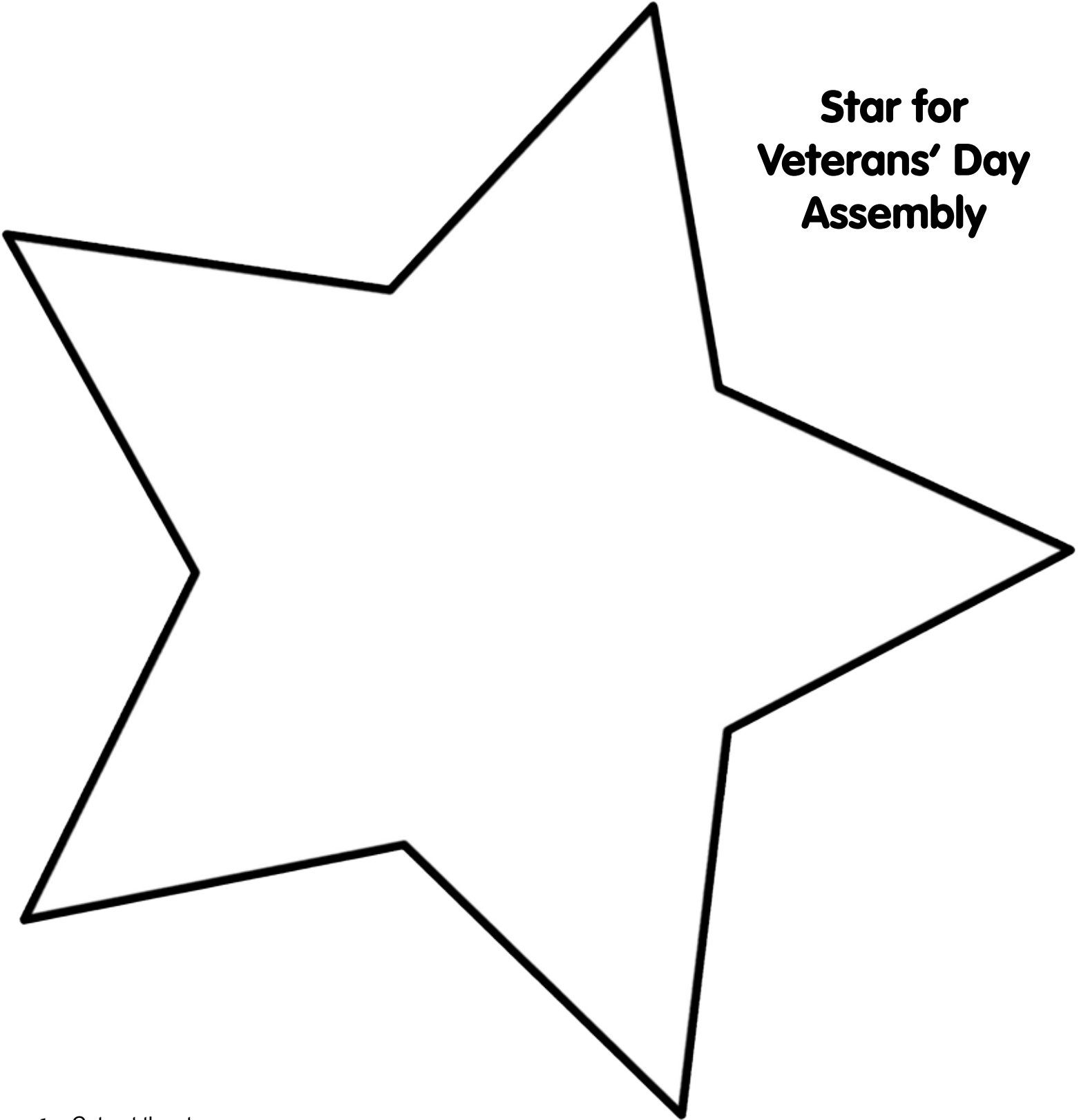


# To honor our Veterans on **VETERANS DAY**

This year, we are asking each family that would like to recognize a Veteran or currently enlisted military to decorate a star in their honor. These stars will be displayed as a tribute to their service. Use this little project as an opportunity to discuss with your child the significance of Veterans Day.

1. Cut out a five point star using the white tag board attached. Be sure to write your name and class color on the back of your star.
  2. On the front, write your family name in the middle of the star. "The Smith Family" or "Susie Smith's Family." On other areas of the star, list the family member who has served, the branch of service, and the date or conflict/theatre in which they served. If you do not have any relatives who have served, you can still create a patriotic star with your family name and a note of Gratitude for our Veterans. \*You may make additional stars for other family members if you wish.
  3. Decorate your stars anyway you wish. Use the colors of red, white and blue to be patriotic! Use your imagination and be creative.  
You could even include pictures of your family members if you choose. These stars will be hung for all to see in honor of our beloved Veterans at our annual Veterans Day assembly.
  4. Please turn in your decorated stars by a Monday, November 2nd.
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# Star for Veterans' Day Assembly



1. Cut out the star.
2. Write the students name and class on the back of the star.
3. Write the name of the veteran, enlisted military person, or the branch of service you wish to honor.
4. Decorate the star anyway you wish using the colors red, white, and blue. Feel free to include photos if you wish.
