



PARK MAITLAND AUDIO & SOUND WORKSHOP (GRADES 1-3)

Workshop is 3 hours in length and promptly begins at 2:35pm and end at 5:35pm.

DESCRIPTION

You've probably been listening to music most of your life, but when is the last time you stopped and seriously listened to the world around you? What did you observe recently? Was it the sound of construction, a crowd of people, birds chirping, a car zooming by, or maybe the sound of silence? Take a moment to appreciate your ears and treat them to the sound of your own music. Work with the app Medley to focus on constructing your feelings into a song, while observing the basics of music theory. Understand Rhythm and how it is used in different genres of music. Share your music with your classmates and exchange creative input. Mostly, have fun listening to, capturing, and creating sound. Learn to make some noise with purpose!

GOAL

Students will use several apps to explore how audio and sound is created, and they will work to create their very own song that will be shared constructively with peers.

OBJECTIVES

Students will be able to:

- Create clips of original music to be used in other projects and full-length songs
- Identify and replicate the beat of a song
- Create a structure, mood, and storyline for a song
- Choose between different instruments and practice identifying individual songs
