


NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH Archdiocese of Seattle



The Year of St. Joseph

This is the Year of St. Joseph! On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis announced a special year dedicated to St. Joseph, continuing until December 8, 2021. This year marks 150 years since Pope Pius IX declared St. Joseph the Patron of the Universal Church. This is a time to get to know and love this special saint.

A Novena of Prayer

Beginning March 10, parishes, schools, and faith communities of the Archdiocese of Seattle are invited to join in a novena of prayer to St. Joseph. These nine days of prayer will be a way for us to prepare to celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, on Friday, March 19.

Using this Novena Prayer Guide

This guide is provided for parishes and schools and includes a simple order of prayer for each day. The brief prayer includes an invitation to prayer with an intention for each day of the novena. A short reading follows, either a Scripture passage or a selection from *Patris Corde*, Pope Francis' letter for the Year of St. Joseph. This can be read by another reader, or by the leader. The novena prayer follows and the prayer concludes with three invocations from the Litany of St. Joseph. This prayer could be used before meetings or classes. In parishes, it could be used before or after Mass, and might be prayed before the parish's statue of St. Joseph.

Novena Prayer – March 10

Invitation to Prayer

Leader:

This is the Year of St. Joseph. As we prepare to celebrate his feast on March 19, we join in a novena of prayer to this great saint, who is intercessor, support, and guide in times of trouble.

Today, let us pray for a greater openness to God's will for us, and the courage to follow wherever God may lead.

Scripture

The angel of the Lord appeared to [Joseph] in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her." (*Matthew 1:20*)

Prayer

Leader: Let us pray.

ALL: Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
To you God entrusted his only Son;
in you Mary placed her trust;
with you Christ became man.
Blessed Joseph, to us too,
show yourself a father
and guide us in the path of life.
Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage,

Invitation to Prayer

Leader:

We continue our novena of prayer to St. Joseph, in preparation for his feast on March 19. Today, let us pray for the “unsung heroes” who have kept us going during the pandemic, especially health care workers, teachers, and essential workers.

Reflection

Pope Francis writes: Each of us can discover in Joseph—the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence—an intercessor, a support, and a guide in times of trouble. Saint Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation. A word of recognition and of gratitude is due to them all. (*Patris Corde*)

Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him.” Joseph rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed for Egypt. (*Matthew 2:13-14*)

Reflection

Pope Francis writes: Our world today has no use for tyrants who would domineer others as a means of compensating for their own needs. It rejects those who confuse authority with authoritarianism, service with servility, discussion with oppression, charity with a welfare mentality, power with destruction. (*Patris Corde*)

We continue our novena of prayer to St. Joseph, in preparation for his feast on March 19. Today, let us pray for husbands and fathers, that they may learn from St. Joseph to be gentle, loving, faithful, and courageous.

Reflection

Pope Francis writes: Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person. (*Patris Corde*)

He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. (Luke 2:48-51)
